

WITNESS REPORTS AND WHAT PEOPLE FELT

Angels, plasma, or just the tape

Short brief for Wednesday's Space. Each card is one case: what was reported, then the emotional or spiritual line only if someone actually said it. "Plasma" in an official caption is a look — a white-hot center — not a claim that the light is a spirit.

How to read a card. Official means a government release (DVIDS, NAVAIR, AARO, Congress). Secondary means a journalist, the filmer's own channel, or a news page. Viral means the clip circulates without an authenticated witness. If the response line says the file is silent, do not supply a feeling on air.

1 · A spiritual reading, in the witness's own words

This is the only catalog case where the filmer later says the lights are conscious and holy. The 2020 page is the footage. The feeling is from his interviews and his book, not from a DoD form.

SECONDARY

Chris Bledsoe — orbs outside his North Carolina home, 2 Aug 2020

Seen. Raw iPhone lights filmed at his house, written up by Punk Rock and UFOs. He has filmed orbs with his family since a 2007 encounter on the Cape Fear River, and he says they change size, from a firefly to a wide ball of light.

Response. He has said the first years were frightening, and that he now considers it "primarily a spiritual phenomenon." He says the lights seem to know a thought before he finishes it, answer when he speaks, and "respond to feeling" in a way a camera cannot hold. He calls a feminine presence the Lady, and he has said he believes the orbs are angelic. He also describes family ridicule and despair, and says the lights answered most clearly when he was at his lowest. Do not add "Virgin Mary." That identification is a commentator's, and he has not made it.

2 · Official red and plasma orbs — behavior, almost no feeling

Four FBI-authenticated civilian videos from the same northeastern region. The captions are careful about color, size, and motion. They do not record prayer, terror, or a religious name for the light. PR002 is the only one that judges the person: the FBI calls that witness highly credible.

OFFICIAL

FBI-UAP-PR004 — two red spheres, July 2025, about 9 p.m.

Seen. A person coming home saw an intense light hovering about 25 feet up in the backyard, roughly 90 feet away. They got out, then went back for a phone. Their spouse came outside and described a brilliant red sphere about a meter across, with a white plasma "sun" the size of a basketball at the center. A second identical orb appeared above the first. Both said the motion was silent and smooth, as if the lights were tethered, and that the two seemed to merge as they went west. iPhone 14 Pro Max.

Response. The release records what they did — stop the car, get the phone, call the spouse out — not how it felt. No fear, awe, or religious language is in the public caption. A later white-orb pass over the house is mentioned in the FBI interview write-up, again without a feeling.

OFFICIAL**FBI-UAP-PR002 — red orb rotation, March 2022**

Seen. Two bright red lights. The lower one appears to rotate relative to the upper. Civilian iPhone 12 Pro, same regional series.

Response. The FBI assesses this witness as highly credible. That is a judgment of the person, not a description of fear or faith. No emotional or spiritual words are in the released summary.

OFFICIAL**FBI-UAP-PR003 — plasma-like sphere over a pond, October 2024**

Seen. A luminous plasma-like sphere over a pond. It changes shape and brightness and seems to break into smaller points. USG-authenticated civilian iPhone clip. This is the official file that uses “plasma-like” as a visual description.

Response. Silent on feeling. Do not treat the word plasma as the witness calling it an angel or a spirit.

OFFICIAL**FBI-UAP-PR001 — triangle orbs, November 2021**

Seen. A bright light resolves into several lights with erratic rotation relative to one another. Same northeastern series. Treated here as the white-light end of the cluster.

Response. Silent on feeling.

3 · Military sensors — surprise on the tape, no prayer

These are not backyard witnesses. The feeling, when any exists, is cockpit talk on the released audio. None of these files contain a spiritual interpretation.

OFFICIAL**Navy FLIR1 — Nimitz “Tic Tac,” November 2004**

Seen. F/A-18 infrared track, released by DoD through the NAVAIR FOIA reading room in April 2020. The public nickname comes from the smooth, featureless shape aircrew described. Not a glowing plasma orb.

Response. The video file itself has no religious statement. In later interviews the pilot who visually acquired it, Cmdr. David Fravor, has described astonishment and an object that seemed to react to his jet, then leave at a speed he could not account for. That is interview memory, not a line burned into the FOIA clip. He has not framed it as an angel.

OFFICIAL**Navy GIMBAL — January 2015**

Seen. Infrared object with a rotating signature, Atlantic fleet, authorized public release.

Response. On the released audio the aircrew are startled and locked on, not reverent. The lines people quote from the tape are “Look at that thing, dude” and “It’s rotating,” plus talk of a fleet of objects. That is excitement and confusion. It is not a spiritual claim.

OFFICIAL**Navy GOFAST — January 2015**

Seen. Infrared object apparently streaking over the Atlantic. Same FOIA release. AARO later published a resolution that treats the kinematics as non-anomalous.

Response. Cockpit tone is surprise while tracking. No spiritual language in the release. Say the later AARO note out loud if someone treats the speed as settled.

OFFICIAL**AARO — silver orb-like object, Middle East, MQ-9, 12 July 2022**

Seen. Sensor clip shown by AARO director Sean Kirkpatrick in an open Senate hearing. A small silver, orb-like object crosses the frame.

Response. No person on the ground describes a feeling. Kirkpatrick's public assessment: the behavior was not anomalous, and the object was still unidentified. Sensor, not a conversion story.

OFFICIAL**Three orb-like cases AARO has tried to close or park**

Seen. Al Taqaddum, Iraq, 2017: aerostat infrared of what AARO assesses as a cluster of balloons. Puerto Rico / Aguadilla, 26 Apr 2013: Customs and Border Protection infrared; AARO says two objects at wind speed and no water entry, against an older claim that something went into the sea. Europe 2024, PR-017: 30 seconds of cellphone video, not enough to say what the subject is. PR-018: long infrared from a U.S. platform; AARO is confident something physical is there and unimpressed by how it moves.

Response. No emotional or spiritual witness statement in any of the four releases. Useful on air as the control group: an orb shape is not, by itself, a plasmate.

4 · Buga — fear, a metallic taste, and a claim of peace

Not a U.S. government file. A metal sphere, about soccer-ball size, reportedly came down at Alto Bonito outside Guadalajara de Buga, Colombia, on 2 March 2025. A companion later called María filmed it. José Arias Restrepo says he picked it up. Treat the health details as his testimony at secondary press events, not as a lab result.

SECONDARY**José and the Buga sphere**

Seen. He says the sphere passed near his head, struck a high-tension line, and fell. He carried it home. He reports a metallic or aluminum taste, nausea, vomiting, and a temporary problem with his fingerprints. He says he told a doctor it was an allergy because he did not want to explain the sphere. He has also said stories that he lost his hair, his teeth, or his life are rumors.

Response. Asked if he was afraid, he said yes, and also curious. His words at a June 2025 press conference, in translation: he got a little scared when he took hold of it, and he also felt “internal peace,” a tranquility he later associated with the object in the house. That is the spiritual-adjacent line. It is his. Commentators have piled prophecy and “non-human” language on top. Keep those in the presenter column, not in his mouth, unless you are playing the clip.

5 · Other civilian clips — thin on feeling

SECONDARY**Antonio Urzi and Simona Sibilla — “Spaceship of Light,” Milan, 5 July 2012**

Seen. Luminous, orb-like object over Italy, uploaded on their own channel. Prefer this to later reuploads.

Response. No separate emotional transcript in the catalog. The spiritual content is the title they chose: a ship of light, not a nuts-and-bolts report. Do not invent a conversion story around it.

SECONDARY**Mosul orb — April 2016 metallic sphere, journalist release**

Seen. Short military-sensor clip of a metallic orb over Mosul, put out through Jeremy Corbell / Weaponized. It is not a NAVAIR or DVIDS file in this pack.

Response. No published feeling from the sensor operator. The awe, if any, belongs to the presenters. Say “journalist-released sensor clip,” not “pilot testimony.”

VIRAL**BIKE MAN — orb over Lake Ontario / Mississauga, 3 Sep 2021**

Seen. An individual YouTube series claims an orb over the lake. The account exists. The government has not authenticated it.

Response. No emotional or spiritual statement is recorded in the catalog entry. Do not borrow Bledsoe’s language for this clip.

SECONDARY**Long Beach — infrared “UAPs ejecting objects”**

Seen. An analysis channel describes infrared objects over Long Beach that appear to release smaller objects. The sensor owner is not identified.

Response. Silent. This is a narrator’s description of a clip, not a witness saying how the sighting felt.

6 · MH370 “teleportation” — not a witness report

An anonymous 2014 upload shows an airliner and three spheres, then a jump cut in which they are gone. The original channel, RegicideAnon, is deleted. There is no named witness, no cockpit, and no spiritual testimony. The clip is widely disputed as a composite. If it comes up, lead with that. The feeling in the comments is audience excitement, which is not evidence.

7 · Hearings — trust and reprisal, not a plasmate testimony

These pages are the official record of the room, not a backyard witness. The emotional subject, where there is one, is institutional: public trust, and whistleblowers saying they fear punishment for speaking. That is not the same emotion as a person watching a red sphere in the yard, and it is not a claim that the objects are angels.

What you can say without leaving the record

- Official red-orb captions describe silent, smooth lights, a white-hot center, and — once — an apparent merge. They do not describe worship, panic, or a message.
- The word plasma in PR003 and PR004 is the government’s visual word. Bledsoe is the one who uses angelic language, years after he says he was afraid.
- The only first-person mix of fear and peace in this set is José, about a metal sphere he says he carried, not about a light in the sky.
- Gimbal’s emotion is on the audio: surprise. It is not reverence.
- MH370 has no witness to ask. Say unverified, then play it or leave it.
- If a caller says “I felt watched, and I felt peace,” you can put them next to Bledsoe and José as the same kind of report — a feeling — and next to the FBI files as something those files do not record.

Sources are the Plasmates catalog of 22 Sep 2026, the DVIDS captions those entries point at, Bledsoe’s public interviews, and José’s answers at a June 2025 press conference carried on secondary video. Nothing here is a medical finding or a lab identification of the Buga metal.
